

# Sam Butalla Intervener Scholarship

Utah State University is pleased to announce that the Sam Butalla Intervener Scholarship is now available to support the education and national credentialing of interveners who work with children who are deafblind and have Peroxisomal Disorders. To be eligible for this scholarship, an applicant must:

- Be willing to complete the USU Intervener Training Program.
- Be committed to obtaining the National Intervener Credential.
- Be working with a child with deafblindness who has a Peroxisomal Disorder. Priority will be given to those applicants currently working with children with Zellweger Spectrum Disorder, including Zellweger syndrome, neonatal adrenoleukodystrophy (NALD), and Infantile Refsum disease.

Funding for this scholarship is provided by **Retrophin**, a biopharmaceutical company.
